Some tactile sensory seekers will love to get wet and messy while others may prefer, controlled, dry fun exploring textures and mouldable toys like playdough and silicone.”



W10 WePlay Sand and Water Sensory Table

This sand and water table offers open-ended tactile exploration where children can scoop, pour, sift, and splash. The different depths and compartments invite hands-on play, allowing children to feel changing textures, temperatures, and resistance. It's a great way to support sensory regulation while naturally building hand strength, coordination, and exploratory play skills.



AC8 Texture Paint Set

This set provides a variety of textured tools that encourage children to explore different sensations through art and mark-making. As they press, roll, and brush, they experience varied tactile feedback that stimulates their sense of touch. It's a creative and calming way to engage sensory seekers while also supporting fine motor control and hand-eye coordination. (Assorted available)



W6 Waterfall Discovery Wall

This interactive water wall invites children to pour, direct, and watch water travel through spinners, channels, and funnels. The flowing water and moving components provide gentle, continuous tactile input while encouraging curiosity and problem-solving. It's ideal for children who enjoy messy play and sensory movement in a controlled, engaging way.



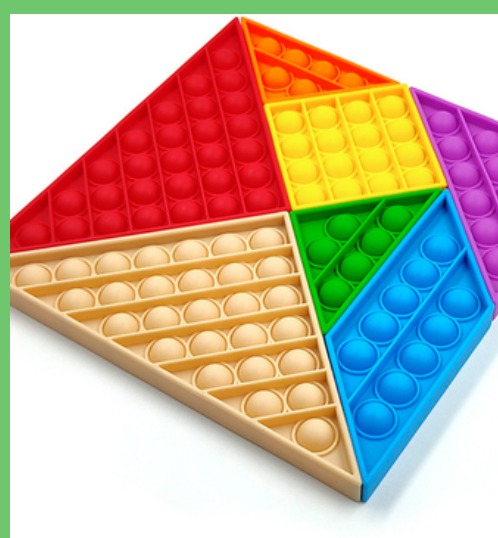
N65 Fat Brain Playtab

The PlayTab offers a range of textured, interactive elements that children can press, slide, spin, and click. Each section provides different tactile feedback, making it highly engaging for sensory seekers who enjoy hands-on manipulation. It also supports fine motor development, concentration, and cause-and-effect understanding through purposeful play.



AC16 Playdough Wooden Stamping Pack

This set encourages children to explore texture through squeezing, rolling, and stamping play dough. The wooden tools create clear imprints and patterns, giving satisfying tactile feedback while strengthening hand muscles. It's a lovely resource for sensory play that also supports creativity, planning, and fine motor precision.



E77 Pop It Bundle
