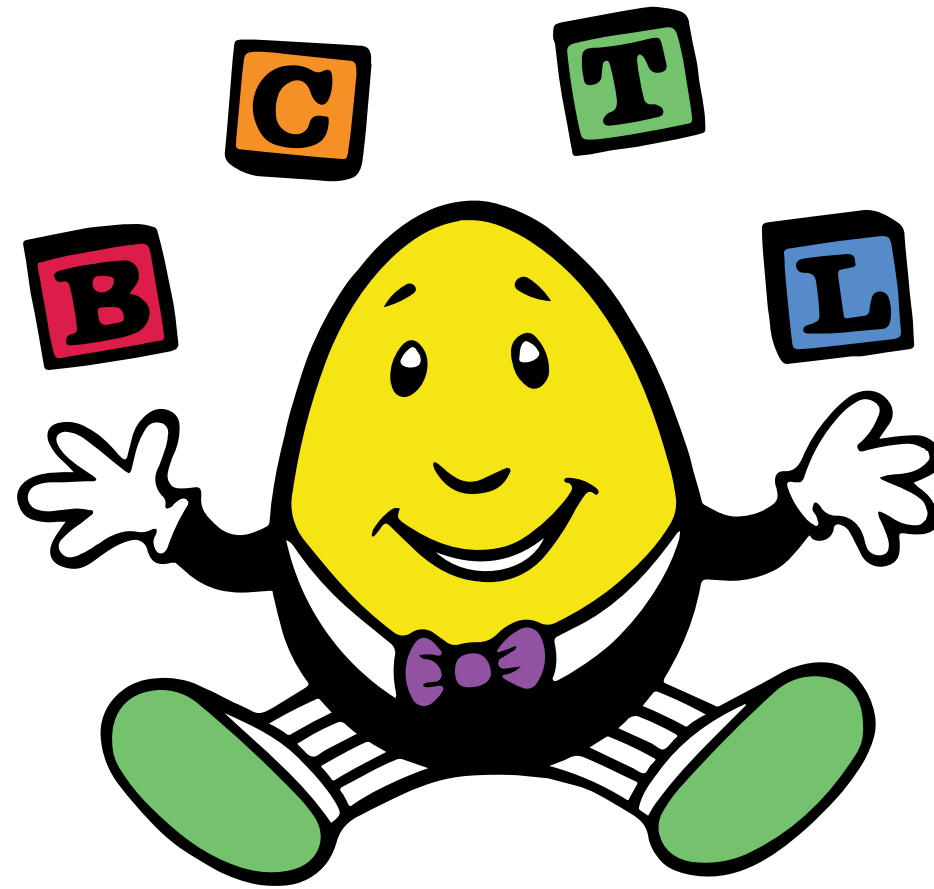


Visiting the Toy Library

Other cars or people might arrive at the same time as me.



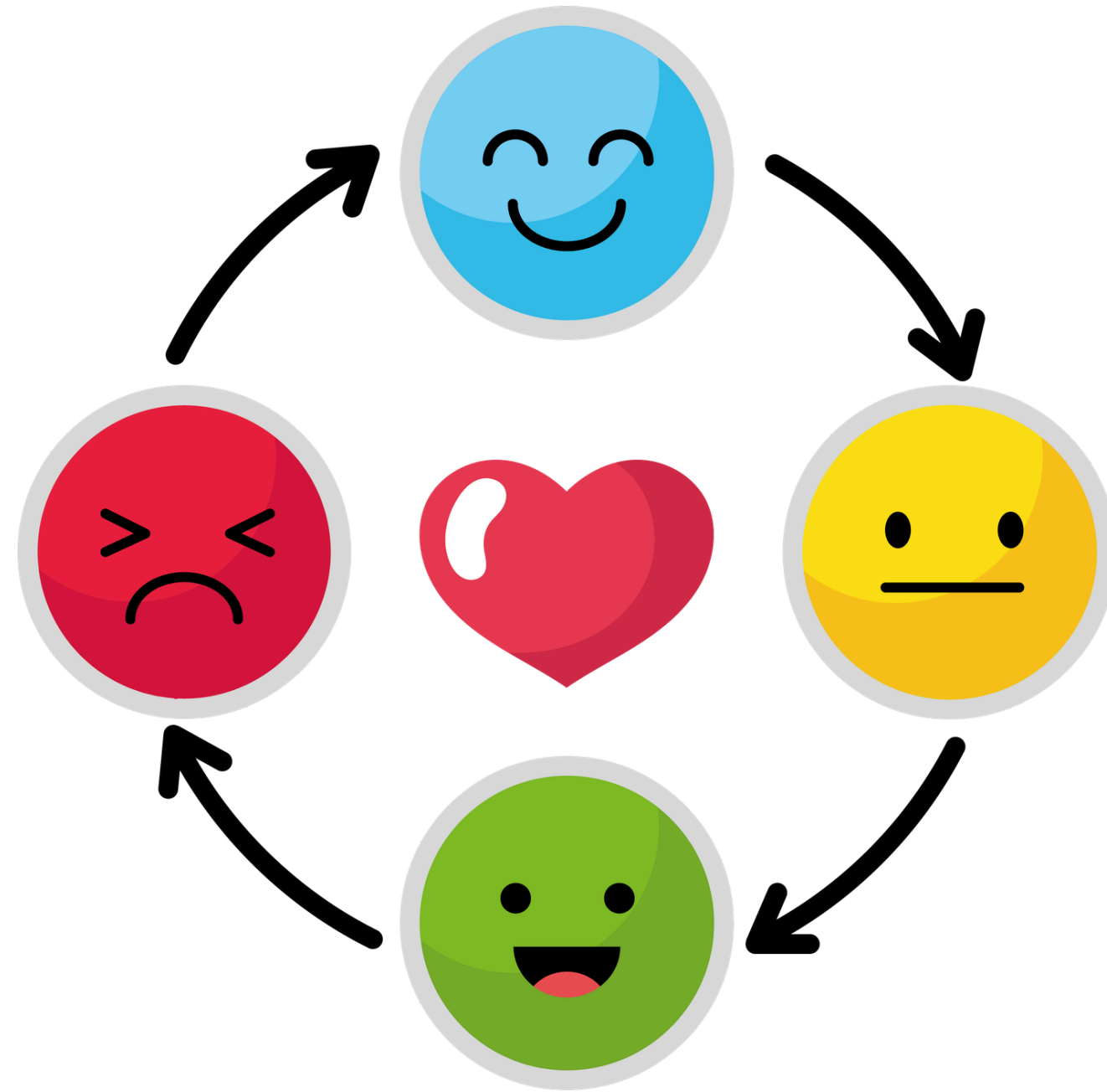
The toy library is a place where I can borrow toys or games to take home and play with.

My grownup will tell me how many things we are choosing today.



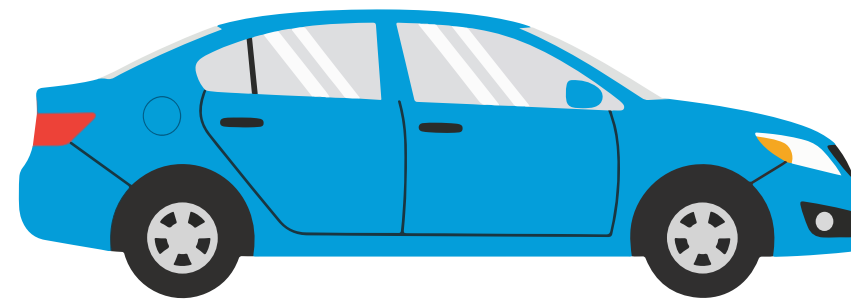
**Sometimes it is hard to pick and I might feel sad or frustrated.
